WATER SUPPLY SHUTDOWN UPDATE

Consumers requested to restrict water use to allow reservoirs to fully recover

While the technicians are still battling with a leak at corner Barrage Rd and Louis Trichardt Blvd, the Water Demand Management (WDM) team has fully recharged the network with reservoirs recovering to 50% full overnight. The team is currently supplying the reservoirs at 85% pumping capacity in order to avoid more pipe bursts.

Owing to high water demand in lower lying areas, reservoirs are slowly recovering. Provided that there are no further interruptions, technicians anticipate that reservoirs will be back to their normal operating levels at midnight (Saturday, 12 June 2021), with consumers in higher-lying areas (CBD, CE and CW Areas) obtaining water supply in the early hours of tomorrow morning (Sunday, 13 June 2021).

The municipality is therefore requesting consumers in lower-lying areas with supply to restrict water use to allow reservoirs to have the best chance to recover by midnight.
