WATER SUPPLY INTERRUPTION UPDATE

Water shortages in Vanderbijlpark and surrounding areas.

As communicated with the residents of Emfuleni Local Municipality yesterday, (Thursday, 03 June 2021), communities in Vanderbijlpark, Bophelong, Bophelong Extensions, Tshepiso, Boipatong and surrounding are hereby notified that the water supply interruption is still in effect.

This is after water at Vanderbijlpark reservoir dropped to critically low levels, resulting in most areas experiencing shortages. The Water Demand Management (WDM) team jointly with a contractor have exposed the damaged pipe at corner Barrage Rd and Louis Trichardt Blvd. Work to repair and reseal the pipe are underway.

Specialized material will be used to reseal the pipe, and the repairs must be allowed to dry for 24 hours before water supply can be restored. The municipality will communicate regular updates on the progress made in restoring water supply to all affected areas.

The municipality is pleading for patience from all affected customers and hereby commits to restore supply as soon as possible. We apologize for the inconvenience.
