WATER SUPPLY SHUTDOWN UPDATE

Emergency repairs continue

Emergency work to repair the water pipeline supplying the Vanderbijlpark reservoirs continues today (Wednesday, 09 June 2021). The Water Demand Management team jointly with Rand Water are currently on site working on efforts to restore supply. Emergency supply to recharge the water network and refill the reservoirs is currently underway. Consumers in lower lying areas will have water later today, while those in higher lying (i.e., Vanderbijlpark CBD, CE and CW Areas) areas will have no water.

No estimated time to normalise water supply can be communicated at this stage. Affected consumers are notified that the municipality has a limited number of water tankers available and as a result, hospitals, clinics and old age homes will be supplied first before attending to communities.
