CONSUMERS REQUESTED TO USE WATER SPARINGLY

Possible water supply interruptions for Vanderbijlpark and surrounding areas.

To enable emergency repairs of a main Rand Water pipeline supplying Vanderbijlpark reservoirs, water supply to Vanderbijlpark, Bophelong, Bophelong Extensions, Tshepiso, Boipatong and surrounding plots will today (Thursday, 03 June 2021) be shutdown.

The Water Demand Management (WDM) teams from the municipality and Rand Water are currently on site jointly assessing the extent of the damage. No ETR can be communicated at this stage however, the teams have advised that repairs might take a few days to complete due to the size and type of the pipe.

Affected customers are therefore requested to use water sparingly to maintain stable water levels at the Vanderbijlpark reservoirs. The municipality further urges affected customers to use water for basic essentials in the coming few days to prevent reservoirs from running out of water.

Updates will be communicated regularly as the water teams provide further information. We apologize for the inconvenience.
