## **WATER SUPPLY SHUTDOWN UPDATE** **Water interruptions extended**

Consumers whose water is supplied from Vanderbijlpark reservoirs are advised that the water supply shut down will continue from 18h00 today (Monday, 07 June 2021). This will be done in order to repair the 1000mm pipe after the seal failed leak tests at full pumping capacity yesterday (Sunday, 06 June 2021).

The municipality has been refilling the reservoirs from early this morning. The reservoirs are currently 40% full and as a result, some of the consumers in lower laying areas have obtained water while those in higher laying areas still have not.

To resume repair work on the leaking pipe, the 1000mm diameter pipeline supplying the reservoirs will be completely drained from 18h00 today. Consumers in Vanderbijlpark, Bophelong, Bophelong Extensions, Tshepiso, Boipatong and surrounding areas will be affected by the shut-down.
